

The Announcement of the Secretariat of the Prime Minister

Integrity and Transparency Policy in Work Operation of

The Secretariat of the Prime Minister

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To be in accordance with the intent of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (interim), B.E. 2557, Official Information Act. B.E. 2540, the Royal Decree on Criteria and Procedures for Good Governance, B.E. 2546, the corruption prevention and suppression strategies, Phase 3 (B.E. 2560 - 2564), the Twelfth National Economic and Social Development Plan (B.E. 2560 - 2564), and in compliance with the government's policies on the state administration with good governance, anti-corruption and misconduct in government agencies, as well as, Action Plan of Secretariat of the Prime Minister, 20 Years (B.E. 2560 - 2579).

To ensure effective administration, transparency and public values for the highest benefits of people and all sectors of society, thus, the Secretariat of the Prime Minister has issued integrity and transparency policy in work operations in order to set standards, common practices and shared values of the agency and all officials to adhere in simultaneity with existing rules and regulations as follows.

1. Transparency

The guidelines:

- 1) Disclose information of the agency to the public or stakeholders to access information easily and quickly.
- 2) Conduct procurement and developing transparency in work operations.
- 3) Provide stakeholders an opportunity to partake in the agency operations.
- 4) Manage complaints on officials' transparency and corruption.

2. Accountability

The guidelines:

- 1) Executives set the direction and management policy, also responsible for any operation mistake.
- 2) Officials shall perform work with resulted-oriented goals and responsible for their performance.

3. Corruption-free Performance

The guidelines:

- 1) Officials shall be fair, transparent, be standard and non-discriminatory.
- 2) Executives formulate the policy is transparent, honest, and unfavorable to stakeholders and private sectors.

4. Corporate Integrity Culture

The guidelines:

- 1) Encourage and create a culture of anti-corruption in all forms.
- 2) Set up an action plan to prevent and suppress corruption in the agency.

5. Work Integrity

The guidelines:

- 1) Executives shall integrate integrity, must adhere to the moral system. Transparency in performance and focus on public interest.
- 2) Manage value-based budget and fairness in work assignment.

6. Communication in the organization

The guidelines:

- 1) Designate operation procedures and communication methods in order to convey integrity and transparency policy in operation of the Secretariat of the Prime Minister.

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
